Goal/Priority: Agency Commitment and Capacity

- Annually at the beginning of each new school year assign sponsor staff to oversee and assist Foxfire Schools, the only school the district sponsors.
- Provide technology support on an on-going basis as needed by the sponsored school.
- Dedicate time and financial resources to ensure the successful operation of the sponsored school.
- Conduct a minimum of four site visits a year (September, December, March, and May) to make sure quality practices are taking place within the sponsored school structure in regard to academics, governance, finance and legal compliance.

Goal/Priority: Application Process and Decision Making

- Application is available online.
- Timeline for the application process is online that spells out all deadlines.
- A team of internal and external evaluators will evaluate the applications. Note: Maysville Local School District is not accepting any applications at this time.

Goal/Priority: Performance Contracting

- Annually in December of each year, review sponsor contracts with sponsored school to ensure that the contract articulates the rights and responsibilities of each party regarding school autonomy, funding, administration and oversight, outcomes, measures for evaluating success or failure, performance consequences, and other material terms (Contract Renewal Form).
- Sponsor contract is available on the sponsor's website.

Goal/Priority: Ongoing Oversight and Evaluation

- Conduct a minimum of four site visits a year (September, December, March, and May) to make sure quality practices are taking place within the sponsored school structure in regard to academics, governance, finance and legal compliance.
- Sponsor representative attends most of the sponsored school's Governing Authority board meetings.
- Sponsor does random informal walk-through site visits throughout the year.
- Enrollment and finances are monitored monthly via communication and documentation between the sponsor treasurer and the community school treasurer.

Goal/Priority: Revocation and Renewal Decision Making

- Quarterly site visits help the sponsor decide if the school is meeting performance standards.
- Contract-renewal is based on the school's performance in the context of the school's accountability plan and the length of the contract. If issues are discovered, Corrective Action, Probation, Suspension or Termination may result dependent upon the results of the evaluation process.
